The Centre

S. N. Bose National Centre for Basic Sciences (established in 1986) is an autonomous institution for advanced scientific research funded by the Department of Science and Technology, Government of India. The Centre has 15 acre lush green campus. The Centre, with a current strength of more than 30 faculties, 15 post-doctoral research staff and about 140 Ph.D has research activities (Theoretical, Computational students. Experimental) in certain focused areas of Physical, Chemical and Mathematical and Astrophysical Sciences. In recent years the Centre has made significant investment to upgrade its experimental research facilities (visit computational facilities the Centre's website http://www.bose.res.in). The Centre runs a residential Post M.Sc. and Post B.Sc. Research Programme. EVLP

The EVLP Programme, fashioned after the structure of ICTP at Trieste, deals with all visitors to the Centre, the postdoctoral fellows, the associates and also arranges all the conference, colloquia, ceremonial lectures and outreach programmes. In addition it promotes a network programme by which conferences will be organised at the Centre by outside organisations.

It is envisaged that such a programme will create scientists at-large in India or abroad, which will lead to better academic visibility of the Centre. The programme will also act as an important vehicle for expanding the science base in the country. The guiding principle is to be making this a truly national programme with international component.

The Candidate:

The Centre invites applications from Indian Nationals working in Central/State Government/Union Territories/Public Sector Undertakings/Autonomous/Semi-Government/Statutory Organizations/ large reputed organisations for the position of **EVLP Programme Coordinator** for appointment on contractual basis for a period of 5 years as per details given below:

Educational Requirement:

Post Graduate in any discipline with at least 55% marks or its equivalent grade **OR** a Graduate (preferably in Science) with a Masters' in Business Administration from a reputed organization.

Experience:

- The candidate must possess minimum 10 years job experience in a Central/State Government/Union Territories/ Public Sector Undertakings/Autonomous/Semi-Government/Statutory Organizations/ large reputed organisations of which he/she should have at least 5 years of experience in educational administration OR comparable experience in research establishment:
- The candidate should possess strong communication skill, knowledge of Rules and regulations pertaining to Government of India, knowledge and related to Service matters in an educational or research Institute, knowledge and proficiency in handling computer aided administration (on line handling of applications, registration, programme management etc.)

Responsibilities:

To manage and coordinate the office of the Visitors' Programme of the Centre which will include visits of short term visitors, associates, Distinguished Lecturers, Summer Project students etc., Post Doctoral Research Associates programme of the Centre, handling of Networked Projects and Exchange Programmes, holding of seminar, colloquia, memorial lectures, conferences and workshops, etc.

Age limit: The maximum age limit for appointment shall not exceed 45 years of age as on the date of publication of the advertisement.

Salary: Rs. 52,714 /- consolidated per month current rate of allowances for employees of Government of India.

Contract Period: Initially for a period of 1 year, extendable upto 5 years subject to yearly review of performance.

General Instructions:

- Candidates drawing a gross salary of less than Rs. 30,000/- per month need not apply.
- Consolidated Salary is based on current rate of allowances for employees of Government of India.
- There shall be no upper age limit in respect of personnel already working in the Centre.

- The upper age limit is relaxable for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Ex-service men, Other Backward Classes, Physically Handicapped and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
